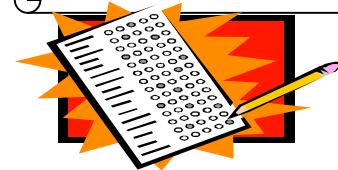

At the end of these competitive two days, Green House emerged victorious (5 years counting). Yellow House was 2nd, Red House was 3rd, and Blue House was 4th.

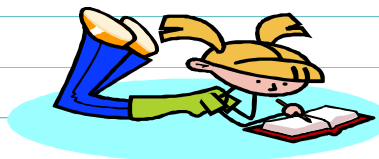
See you all again next year when Yellow, Red and Blue attempt to de-throne the champions .....Green House.

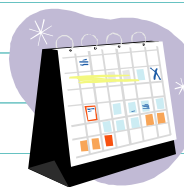
